

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR
SANTA FE ALLIANCE FOR SCIENCE**

The Santa Fe Alliance for Science (SFAFS) is searching for a new Executive Director. This is a half-time paid position.

SFAFS is a non-profit, volunteer organization helping Santa Fe's K-14 students become more proficient in math and science. It provides: (1) extensive support and judging for most school science fair programs in Santa Fe; (2) after-school tutoring in math and science at local high schools and the Santa Fe Community College (SFCC); (3) an evening "Santa Fe Science Cafe for Young Thinkers" series where the frontiers of science are discussed; and (4) a program of professional enrichment workshops for teachers. In the 2014-15 academic year about 100 volunteers contributed almost 5,000 contact hours to SFAFS programs, involving about 5,000 student interactions. More information about SFAFS can be found at www.sfafs.org. SFAFS is funded by a new three-year grant from the National Science Foundation as well as donations from the Santa Fe community.

The Executive Director (ED) oversees the day-to-day activities of SFAFS by working closely with the directors of the four programs, and reporting to the SFAFS Board of Directors. The ED is also the primary interface between SFAFS and (1) schools in Santa Fe (mainly the SFPS district and SFCC), (2) the volunteers, (3) the community, and (4) funding sources.

We seek a self-starter committed to improving K-14 math and science education in the Santa Fe community. Good organizational, record-keeping, and communication skills, as well as the ability to work independently within a diverse community (including peers, teachers, school administrators and students), are essential. Previous teaching or research experience in a STEM-based discipline is highly desired. Familiarity with the education environment in Santa Fe would be a plus. The term of appointment is one year with the possibility of re-appointment if mutually agreeable. Candidates from all parts of Santa Fe's diverse community are urged to apply.

Applicants should submit both a short curriculum vitae and a one-page (at most) statement of interest and qualifications.
